LAS VEGAS, March 14, 2005 – Rock legend Stevie Nicks is scheduled to appear in a never-before-seen concert experience created exclusively for The Colosseum at Caesars Palace. "Dreams," a four show engagement presented jointly by Caesars Palace and AEG Live, will take place on Tuesday, May 10, Wednesday, May 11, Friday, May 13 and Saturday, May 14.

As a singer/songwriter solo artist and as a member of pop music's famed Fleetwood Mac, Stevie Nicks has enjoyed phenomenal success. The artist, born in Phoenix, Arizona, joined Fleetwood Mac in January 1975 and the band went on to sell well over 50 million albums. Their classic multi-Grammy award winning album *Rumours* is considered by experts and fans alike to be one of the greatest albums recorded in the history of rock and roll. Nicks penned several hits as part of Fleetwood Mac including "Rhiannon", "Dreams" and "Landslide".

Her most recent solo album *Trouble in Shangri-La* returned Nicks to the top of the charts in 2001. Nicks has performed in concert as a solo artist and as an ongoing member of Fleetwood Mac throughout her much heralded career to a large army of devoted fans of all ages.
